






3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

SCI has 87 Editorial Board Members from 13 countries. Among them, 52% from USA, 9% from Italy and 5% from UK etc.


6% Others include Belgium, France, Spain, New Zealand and India.






5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2017




6. International Diversity of Corresponding

Switzerland etc.


